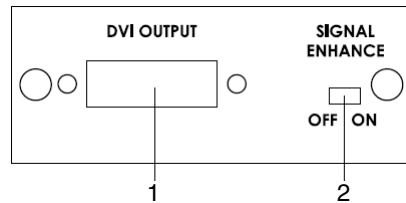

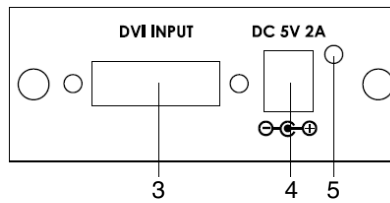

Rear Panel



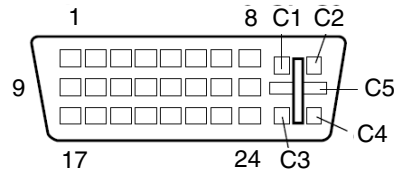
Front Panel

- 5 - Power LED

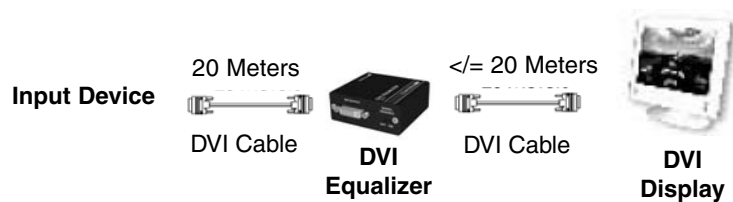
DVI Pin Configuration

The DVI-I interface supports both digital and analog connections to the display. This 29 pin connector can carry single or dual-link all-digital video/data signals and ground.

Installation



1. Remove power from the signal source and display.
2. Locate DVIEQ such that it is near an available power outlet.
3. Connect DVIEQ to a nearby power outlet, using the power adapter provided.
4. Connect the signal source to the DVIEQ DVI INPUT port, using standard DVI-I cable.
Please note that if you are using cables of differing length, the longer of the two cables (up to 20m) is used to connect the input source to the equalizer, for a total extension distance between host and display of 40 metres
5. Connect the DVIEQ DVI OUTPUT port to the display using standard DVI-I cable.
6. Restore power to the signal source and display.
7. If necessary, activate the Signal Enhance function.
