Introduction

The SATDOCK22RU3 USB 3.0 to SATA Hard Drive Duplicator Dock lets you duplicate/clone an existing hard drive without the use of a host computer system, or it can be connected to a computer system for use as a standard external hard drive dock.

In Duplicator Mode, it creates an exact 1-to-1 sector clone from one hard drive to another, including partition and boot sector information and all data - ensuring data integrity and consistency for sensitive operations, such as data recovery. Direct drive-to-drive copying over the native SATA II bus, allows the SATA drives to hit their optimal SATA II read/write performance, without a computer or being bottle necked by another bus, like USB.

In Dock Mode, it can be connected to your host computer through USB 3.0, providing up to 5 Gbps of bandwidth from both hard drives to your computer system. The value of this hard drive docking station can be further extended through a SATA to IDE hard drive adapter (SAT2IDEADP), which enables you to use any 2.5 or 3.5in IDE hard drive in a SATA hard drive dock slot.

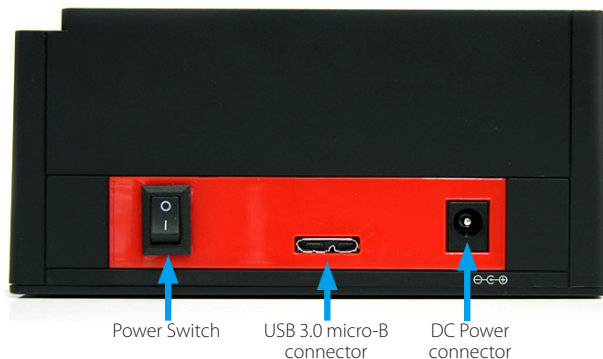
System Requirements

- 2.5in and/or 3.5in SATA hard drive(s) or solid state drive(s)
 - Available AC electrical outlet
 - **Docking Station Mode:**
 - USB enabled computer system with available USB port
 - Microsoft® Windows® XP/ Server 2003/ Vista/ Server 2008 R2/ 7 (32/64-bit), or Apple® Mac OS® X, or Linux®
- *If used with the Apple Mac OS operating system, this device will function in USB 2.0 mode only as Apple does not yet support USB 3.0

Installation



WARNING! Hard drives and storage enclosures require careful handling, especially when being transported. If you are not careful with your hard disk, lost data may result. Hardware Installation

Docking Station Mode

1. Connect the external power adapter to the docking station.
2. Insert 1 or 2 SATA drives into the drive bays on the docking station.
3. Connect the USB cable from the hard drive dock to the computer system.
4. Power on the docking station by pressing the power switch located on the rear side of the docking station. The Power LED will light up solid.
5. The operating system should now detect the hard drive(s) and make them available. The hard drives may need to be partitioned/formatted using a disk management utility before you can access them (see "Using the Storage Device" for reference).

Duplicator Mode

1. Connect the external power adapter to the docking station.
2. Make sure the USB cable is not connected to the docking station and/or the host computer system.
3. Insert the 2 SATA drives into the drive bays on the docking station. Make sure to place the drive with the data you want copied (Source) into the "A" or "Source" bay.

NOTE: The drive to receive the data (Destination) needs to be equal or larger in capacity than the source disk.

4. Power on the hard drive dock by pressing the power switch located on the rear side of the docking station. The Power LED will light up solid.
5. Once both drives are ready, the LED for each drive will light up solid.
6. Press and hold the "Clone" button for several seconds until the LED for 100% lights up, then release and press the "Clone" button again to begin duplication. The progress bar will indicate how much of the duplication is complete. Once complete, the entire bar will be lit solid.

NOTE: Cloning will automatically stop if bad sectors are encountered during duplication. Ensure the drive is healthy before attempting to clone.

NOTE: Drives with EISA or protected partitions cannot be duplicated.

Driver Installation

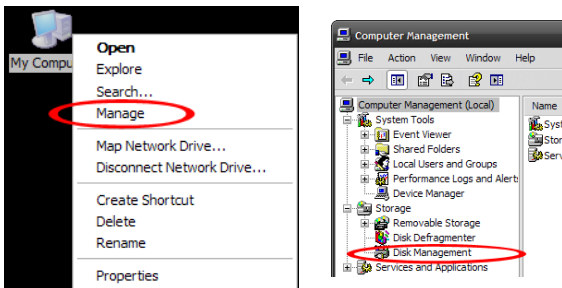

No driver installation is required for the supported operating systems, as this hard drive dock is natively supported, so the drivers are already installed.

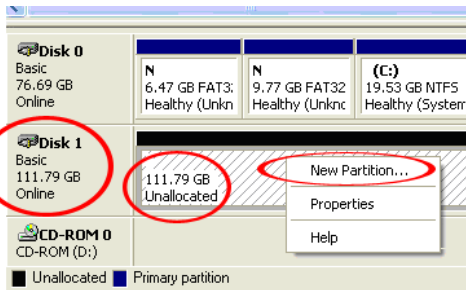
Using the Storage Device

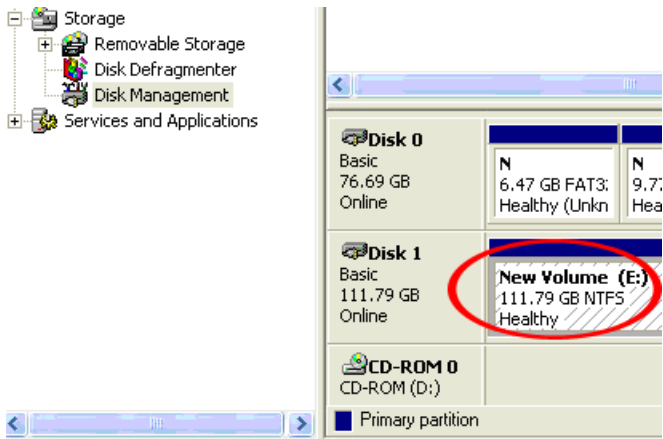
If you are using a brand new hard drive that does not contain any data in Docking Station Mode, then you will first need to prepare the hard drive for use. From the main desktop, right-click on "My Computer" ("Computer" in Vista/7), then select Manage. In the new Computer Management window, select Disk Management from the left window panel.



Locate the Disk that says it is "Unallocated" (check hard drive capacity to confirm it's the correct hard drive) and then right-click in the section that says "Unallocated" and select "New Partition".



The New Partition Wizard will appear. Follow the instructions in the wizard to complete setting up the drive. Once complete, the Disk should show up as “Healthy” with a drive letter assigned (i.e. E:). This drive letter should now appear within My Computer.



If you are installing a hard drive that already has data on it, then after plugging it in, the drive should automatically show up with a drive letter assigned within My Computer.
