- Microsoft® Windows® 2000/XP/Server 2003/Vista/ Server 2008 R2/7 (32/64-bit) or Apple® Mac OS® 10.5 or Linux kernel 2.6.18 or later

Installation

- 1. Power on the computer system and boot into Windows
- Connect the USB adapter into an available USB port.Windows will automatically detect the new hardware.
- 3. Insert the included CD into the computer's CD/DVD drive.
- 4. AutoPlay should launch the installation splash screen. If not, navigate to the CD via "My Computer" and run the setup.exe.
- 5. Select the Install Driver option and proceed with the installation.
- Once complete, the drivers for the USB adapter should be installed.



Verifying Installation

From the main desktop, right-click on "My Computer" ("Computer" in Vista/7), then select Manage. In the new Computer Management window, select Device Manager from the left window panel.

Double-click on the "Modems" option and a new device should be present.
