

- USB enabled computer system with available USB port
- Microsoft[®] Windows[®] XP/ Server 2003/ Vista/ Server 2008 R2/ 7/ 8 (32/64-bit), or Apple[®] Mac OS[®] 10.x, or Linux[®]

Installation

NOTE: Supplying external power is optional, however to ensure that each USB port is fully powered, connecting external power is recommended.

- 1. If not using external power, skip to Step 4. Using a small flat head screw driver, loosen the screws for the terminal block connectors.
- Connect the power and ground wires from your DC power source to the proper terminal block connectors and fasten the screws. The terminals are marked on the USB Hub's housing.
- 3. Insert the terminal block housing into the USB Hub.
- 4. Connect the USB cable from the USB hub (type B port) to the host computer system. With power being supplied (either from the terminal block or USB host connection), the power LED should light up solid.
- 5. The operating system should detect the USB Hub immediately and automatically install it.
- 6. Once installation is complete, USB devices should be able to be connected to the hub and recognized.
